## **BYLAWS OF THE BOARD**

## **Oath or Affirmation**

Prior to entering upon the duties of their office, all Board members shall take the oath or affirmation required by law.

The oath may be administered and certified by a Board member, Secretary to the Board, County Superintendent of Schools, Deputy or Assistant Superintendent, or any other person authorized in Education Code § 60.

The executed oath shall be filed with the County Clerk.
