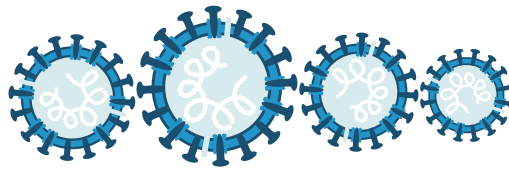

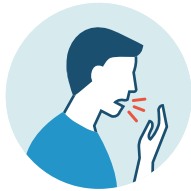
Health Information

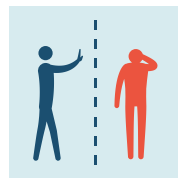

PREVENTION



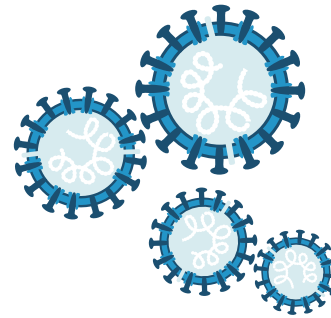
WASH HANDS WITH

WITH SICK PEOPLE



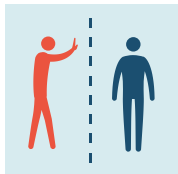
DON'T TOUCH EYES,

UNWASHED HANDS



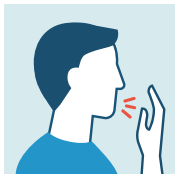
IF YOU ARE SICK
