1. Decreasing the Number of Board of Education Trustees and Creating New Trustee Areas in the Linden Unified School District: President Vogel opened the public hearing in order to discuss and receive input from the public relative to the decrease in the number of Board of Education trustees from seven to five and the subsequent creation of new trustee areas to accommodate the lesser number of trustees in the Linden Unified School District.

Superintendent Rick Hall reported the proposal has been a consideration and process for the Linden Unified Board of Education for the past three years and he hopes that the process continues to move forward.

Fifteen additional minutes were provided to allow members of the public to join the teleconference and there were no other comments. The public hearing was closed.
