Resolution #20-03 – Banta Elementary School District Unification: On a motion from Vern Gebhardt, second by Greg Clark, the County Committee approved this resolution in support of the petition for the reorganization of a portion of the Tracy Unified School District to form a Banta Unified School District within the boundaries of the Banta Elementary School District as presented. It was the consensus of the County Committee, that if the unification of the Banta Elementary School District is approved by the voters, the district will transition from an at-large voting structure to a by-trustee area voting structure as soon as possible after the 2020 Census data is certified and made available.
